



# Travel plan



DAY 1 (October 23. 2025. - Thursday) / ISTANBUL

Arrival in Istanbul – a city where East meets West, tradition embraces modernity, and continents connect. Hotel accommodation. Overnight stay.

DAY 2 (October 24. 2025. - Friday) / ISTANBUL / BOSPHORUS & TAKSIM

Breakfast. Free time or an optional excursion with a local guide: A magical cruise along the deep blue waters of the Bosphorus – offering breathtaking views of the Dolmabahçe Palace, ancient fortresses, lavish Ottoman mansions, and the iconic bridges that link two worlds – Europe and Asia. Visit to the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople, the spiritual center of Orthodoxy. Walk across the famous Taksim Square, the heart of modern Istanbul, filled with shops, restaurants, and the vibrant Istiklal pedestrian street. Return to the hotel. Overnight stay.

DAY 3 (October 25. 2025. - Saturday) / ISTANBUL / COMPETITION / ISTANBUL'S TREASURES Breakfast. The morning is reserved for the competition. In the afternoon, optional guided sightseeing of some of the city's most iconic historical landmarks: The Grand Bazaar – the oldest and most colorful covered market in the world; The Blue Mosque – an architectural masterpiece of the Ottoman era; Hagia Sophia – a magnificent symbol of history and transformation; Topkapi Palace – once the residence of the sultans and treasury of Ottoman splendor (entrance fees not included). Free time for individual activities. Overnight stay.

#### DAY 4 (October 26. 2025. - Sunday) / ISTANBUL / ASIAN SIDE & SHOPPING Breakfast. Hotel check-out.

Optional excursion to the mystical Asian side of Istanbul – a part of the city where the spirit of the old world still whispers through the Bosphorus breeze. Ascend to Çamlıca Hill, where a divine panorama unfolds over the city of minarets and domes – a place where East and West merge under the golden sun and eternal silhouettes. Optionally, visit the "Venice" shopping mall – a one-of-a-kind themed complex inspired by the famous Italian city. Stroll along picturesque canals and bridges, surrounded by Venetian-style architecture, and enjoy shopping in boutiques of world-renowned brands – an experience that blends the elegance of Italy with the soul of Istanbul.

## Important!!!

Special awards are valid only for the festival for which they were granted and with mandatory use of our accommodation.

Exchanging them between festivals is not allowed.

#### Mandatory:

Each participating club is REQUIRED to sign a consent form for the use of photographs taken by the engaged professional photographers, which will be used by the Dance Now Organization for dance promotion purposes. If a child does not have parental consent, the club director MUST inform the photographer and the organizer; in that case, the entire choreography in which the child participates will NOT be photographed!!!
